LIVING ON BORROWED RESOURCES

We only have one Earth...so it's time to start living like it. We're using resources faster than Earth creates them, and future generations will pay.

Natural disasters and greenhouse gas emissions are at an all-time high, and unfortunately, human habits are to blame. Humanity's ecological footprint is 60% carbon, which is rapidly depleting the planet's natural resources.



How is this information calculated?

Customer Savings: Powur estimated lifetime savings for systems installed by Powur by using the average estimated customer savings presented on Powur customer solar proposals. Lifetime savings estimates on proposals factor in available data such as 1) system size, 2) estimated system production (which is impacted by shading, roof face, panel efficiency and other factors), 3) current utility rate or replacement cost, 4) estimated future utility rate or replacement cost, 5) financing cost, and 6) an average system lifetime of 25 years.

Avoided Carbon Emissions. Powur uses true aggregated customer data to obtain total system size and estimated lifetime production for 2022 installations to arrive at the total number of kilowatt hours of energy that will be replaced by solar installation and therefore the equivalent amount of estimated lifetime avoided kilowatt hours of energy generated by fossil fuels. In arriving at this figure we assume 1) that 100% of electricity produced by installed systems will be used either directly at the home where it is produced or through net metering flowing back to the grid and 2) an average system lifetime of 25 years. The final amount of avoided kwh of energy is then input into the EPA greenhouse gas equivalency calculator to arrive at the total estimated lifetime avoided carbon emissions from systems installed by Powur. The equivalent impacts (e.g. trees planted or miles not driven) are also calculated using the EPA calculator located at https://www.epa.gov/energy/greenhouse-gas-equivalencies-calculator.





Powur team members don't have to choose between life and work, job and family. Our culture focuses on output and results, with flexibility of WHEN team members schedule their work around their family lives.




REGIONAL EXPERTISE

Head of Administration, Beth has been here since Day 1.


Beth Robinson is no stranger to hard work and getting the job done, but when she began her work with Powur in 2009, what she thought was just a job became her life's mission.


"I never felt like I was working FOR her, I was working WITH her to support a greater mission," Beth reflects.

SOLAR 101:

HOW IT WORKS



Solar is essential to the future of energy, but it's really just the beginning. More than half of US car sales will be electric by 2030, and the market for advanced energy solar systems is predicted to reach \$46.5 billion this year. In the future, solar systems will power EV charging stations, energy storage, and so much more. Homeowners will have even more ways to embrace clean, renewable energy and reduce their dependence on the grid—even as natural disasters and power outages increase.

Here's how it works:



Sunlight turns into DC: Solar panels convert sunlight into direct current (DC) electricity.



DC converts to AC: An inverter converts DC into alternating current (AC) electricity—the power used to turn on appliances.



3 Clean energy powers the home:
Homeowners use the clean energy
generated from the panels, and excess
power is delivered back to the grid through
net metering.



4 Power companies give homeowners a credit for excess power supplied, and only charge the net difference on utility bills.



MAINTAINING YOUR PANELS



Trim trees

If you've had your panels for several years, you may need to trim mature tree branches to ensure your panels receive maximum exposure to sunlight.




Check your inverter

Your solar inverter is doing some heavy lifting, so check on it a couple of times a year to make sure LED lights are green and in normal operation.



Annual inspection

To make sure your panels are always in working order, it's smart to hire a professional to inspect your panels once a year.



The following are some tips on how to take care of your solar panels in any climate.



Annual cleaning

Your solar panels perform best when they're free of dirt and debris. Rain can help with this, but it's still a good idea to hire a professional to clean your panels 1-2 times a year.



Maintenance as needed

Notice an issue with your solar panels? Don't put it off—schedule a maintenance appointment right away to minimize the issue.





Their efforts promote sustainability, protect the rights of Indigenous people, and remind people of humanity's sacred relationship to the Earth.

We've planted 27,984 trees in Madagascar, Mozambique, Nicaragua, Peru, and more, offsetting 3,631.27 tonnes of carbon and generating more than three years of climate impact for our planet.



LANDFILL GAS **EXTRACTION**

We've helped collect landfill gas produced in Brazil's landfills and used it to generate 354,968 MWh of electricity.



WATER SECURITY

We've restored watershed functions and soil stability in Kenya, helping ensure water security for millions of people.



HYDROPOWER

We're generating clean energy from hydropower in the Himalayas of India and Uganda, preventing more than 17,614 t CO2e from being emitted every year.



WIND POWER

We've funded wind farms in Thailand and Honduras, preventing more than 250,000 tonnes of CO2 from being emitted into the atmosphere every year.

Paul Hawken, friend of Powur and frequent speaker and panelist at our training events said it best: "being a good human being is good business."

It's true. Each one of us goes home enriched after these builds. We invite other companies and individuals to join us as we demonstrate that with the right intentions and the right actions, business can be the greatest catalyst for good in the world today.



A ROOF OVER THEIR HEAD AND A NEW FUTURE

In the spring of 2022, the Powur team took our inaugural trip to Mexico to build a home from start to finish for the Estrada Lopez family.

The Lopez family are no strangers to hard work. Both started working when very young, setting aside many of their life dreams and goals just to make ends meet. As a family, they had been praying for a house for years. They both worked in a packing house earning the equivalent of just \$160 a week. What's more is that half of their income went to life-saving epilepsy medication for their son, Uriel, making it impossible for them to consider how they would afford their own home, let alone one with electricity. They saved up for years to be able to buy their land (it's a requirement for families applying for the home build program to own their own land) and were thrilled when their family was selected.

During the build, despite a language barrier for most participants, a close bond was created between Francisco, Esperanza, Uriel and the Powur team. All worked side by side together and the family was extremely invested in the people and the process to create their new home. And it's not all work and no play. The build team met a dog who chased and caught rocks and made time for high jump competitions on the newly built walls. Wherever we are in the world, you can count on the Powur team to bring laughter and a good time.



LOVE LIVES HERE.

You don't need to speak the same language to feel the love and dedication a single mother has for her children. It was our honor to serve Gina Solis and her daughters for our second home build in the fall of 2022.

Gina works as a housekeeper and earns about \$70 on a good week. Over many years, Gina saved enough to own a small plot of land and dreamt of providing her daughters with a home.

Despite going through a divorce and the death of her father, Gina remains hopeful that the best is yet to come.



We have heard updates from Gina and her girls who have since added a bathroom to their home and have built a fence to create a private yard. They sent us a picture of their home with holiday lights outside in December, which felt more festive than the most grand holiday display. They plan to plant a garden this spring and enjoy food grown in their own garden and cooked in their own kitchen. These are simple but profound steps to a new life, powered by community.
